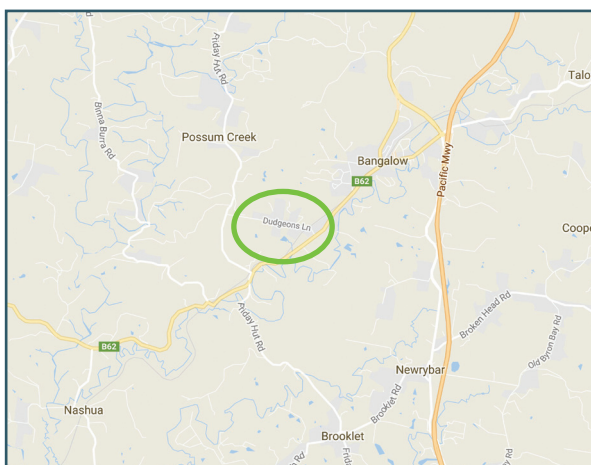
### What you need to bring and wear:
